

Welland Curling Club – Monday/Tuesday Club Championship 2018 – 2019

Playoff Format

1. After the first round, points will be totaled. The top 8 teams will go into A pool, the next 8 teams go into B pool, the next 6 teams go into C pool and the remaining 6 teams go into D pool.
2. After the second round, the same process will be used and total points from round 1 and 2 will be used to determine pool groupings.
3. After the third round, the total points from round 1, 2, and 3 will be used to determine the playoff groupings as noted below.
4. Playoff groupings will be as follows:
 - Top 4 teams, playoff in a “page” format for the Club Championship
 - The next 4 Teams, 5 to 8 play off in a “page” format for the A Event Consolation Winner
 - The next 4 Teams, 9 to 12 play off in a “page” format for the B Event Winner.
 - The next 4 Teams, 13 to 16 play off in a “page” format for the C Event Winner.
 - The next 4 teams, Teams 17 to 20 play off in a “page” format for the D Event Winner.
 - The next 4 teams, 21 to 25 play off in a “page” format for the E Event Winner.
 - The last 4 teams, 25 to 27 play off in “page” format for the F Event Winner.
5. Playoff Rules
 - Spare rule is the same as during the regular season.
 - No curfew. Ties are a full end toward the glass.
 - Highest ranking team from season play has option of "hammer" or "colour" in the first end of the first and second round of playoffs. The final round of playoffs will have winner of the 1 vs 2 game have choice of " hammer" or "colour" in the first end of the championship game.
